- ♣ Talk with neighbors, friends, business associates about GSE;
- ♣ Rotarians in clubs who strongly support their alma maters, and whom may be actively involved with alumni associations, should try to make connections and promote GSE opportunities;
- ♣ Reach out to Ambassadorial Scholars that your club has sponsored;
- ♣ Make GSE part of your everyday conversation. And emphasize application deadline of October 30th for Team Members.
- ♣ Seek out potential Team Member candidates by targeting vocations. Some ideas include:
